VALUE ADDED COURSES

Making students better prepared to meet demands of the profession as well as to develop their interests and aptitude is possible through supplementing curriculum with value added courses. Value added courses help the students to develop their skills, teaching and ensure the development of life skills. The value added courses offered to increase the employability quotient of our students with essential skills to succeed in life.

Course Learning Outcomes:

After completion of the course the trainee will be able to:

- Acquire specialized knowledge and skills in their respective fields.
- Bridge the skill gap and become ready for teaching profession.
- Enhance their professional competencies and career prospects.

Guidelines for conducting value added course:

- Classes for Value Added Courses are conducted during weekdays under regular working hours.
- Resources persons from other institutions shall be invited along with in-house staff for conduction of the classes.
- For each course there will be course coordinators for smooth conduction of the course.
- A student shall be permitted to register only one value added course in a session.

List of value added courses offered in our institution:

- 1. English for professional Communication (VAC-01)
- 2. Waste Management and Recycling (VAC-02)
- 3. Cyber Safety (VAC-03)

The courses are mandatory for all students.

Duration of the course

The duration of the value added course shall be for 2 unit (60 hours) combination of theory and practical.

Rules for Admission in Value Added Courses

- College students can take direct admission after announcing of admission date of this course.
- Class conducted two days in a week in the evening after/before regular course classes.
- 3. All learners must adhere to starting and finishing times.
- 4. All mobile phones must be switched off during the classes of course.
- After completion of curriculum/syllabus of the course examination will be conducted for the issuance of certificate.
- 6. The assessment of the course will be done through grading system.
- Students will be awarded with a certificate on successful completion of the course.

Examination and Evaluation

Evaluation of Value Added Courses is purely internal. Each course followed by objective type written examination for fifty marks at the end of each year along with end of annual university examination. Evaluation will be done by the course coordinators.

Award of Certificates

The learners who successfully complete the Value Added Courses shall be issued a certificate duly signed by the authorized signatory of the institution and course in charge. The grade eared in VAC shall be entered in the grade sheet.


